Professional Development Spring 2012 Courses

Episode 1: It's The Little Things (airs Monday, Jan. 9 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Friday, Jan. 13 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

The program discusses the challenge to develop appropriate daily routines for children which offer them a sense of consistency and security, yet remain flexible and responsive to the individual needs of each child.

Episode 2: By Leaps and Bounds (airs Friday, Jan. 13 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Saturday, Jan. 14 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

The program explores how we can learn so much about children's abilities and needs simply by observing them.

Episode 3: Babies are Children, Too (airs Monday, Jan. 16 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Friday, Jan. 20 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

This program focuses on providing consistent, one-on-one relationships with infants and toddlers in group settings.

Episode 4: Dealing with Feelings (airs Friday, Jan. 20 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Saturday, Jan. 21 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

In this program, our challenge is to learn how to help children cope with their feelings and express them in socially acceptable ways that don't harm others and are appropriate to the child's age and abilities.

Episode 5: I'm Glad I'm Me (airs Monday, Jan. 23 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Friday, Jan. 27 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

This program examines how we let children know that we care about them, that we accept and approve of them, no matter what.

Episode 6: Listening to Families (airs Friday, Jan. 27 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Saturday, Jan. 28 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

This program focuses on getting along with families and genuinely welcoming them into the school.

Episode 7: Everybody's Special (airs Monday, Jan. 30 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Friday, Feb. 3 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

The program discusses humane, effective ways of approaching parents when a referral for special help seems to be necessary and also includes advice on how the teacher should function as a member of the transdisciplinary team.

Episode 8: Getting Along Together (airs Friday, Feb. 3 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Saturday, Feb. 4 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

The program explores the challenge to learn how to help each child begin to develop into a socially-competent person who can express his own feelings, empathize with others' feelings, and be cooperative, generous and kind.

Episode 9: Building Inner Controls (airs Monday, Feb. 6 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Friday, Feb. 10 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

The program explores self-control, and how as teachers we teach students to control themselves instead of depending on other people to control them.

Episode 10: Respecting Diversity (airs Friday, Feb. 10 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Saturday, Feb. 11 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

The program reflects and stimulating ideas for role-playing situations.

Episode 11: Creativity and Play (airs Monday, Feb. 13 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Friday, Feb. 17 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

The program explores the ability to be creative, to create something from personal feelings and experiences, can reflect and nurture children's emotional health.

Episode 12: Let's Talk About It (airs Friday, Feb. 17 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Saturday, Feb. 18 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

In this program, we're going to look at traditional ways to help children learn language as well as interesting new ideas about laying foundations for later success in reading and writing, an area of study called emergent literacy.

Episode 13: Growing Minds (airs Monday, Feb. 20 @ 12:30-1pm/ repeats Friday, Feb. 24 @ 5:30-6:30AM)

This program stresses basic learning priorities like maintaining children's sense of wonder and curiosity, binding cognitive learning to affective experience whenever possible and accompanying it with language.
