

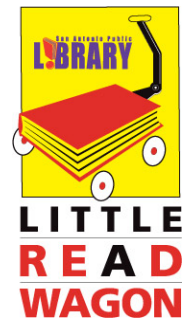

- The written out words to a favorite song, rhyme, or chant that you use at work. Be prepared to teach others how to sing it or do it. You will be turning this in at the end of training.
- Bring your library card, or a photo ID so that you may get one, if you live in Bexar County.
- An empty tissue box (the square kind would be preferable) to recycle into an activity prop.
- Lunch, a drink, and a snack. Coolers are permitted. No microwave will be available.
