## CROSS-CURRICULAR & EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

### LANGUAGE ARTS

- Presentations may be made for example showing a paragraph to the class and having them correct it on their papers.
- A review game could perhaps have grammatical errors within a sentence and the first to correct it would win.

### MATH



- Make categories that deal with different disciplines such as adding, dividing, and increase the difficulty for more points.

### **SCIENCE**

- Using animation you can trace the digestive tract or incorporate video from internet sources.

### **ECT.**

- All disciplines can use PowerPoint as a way to introduce a new topic in an exciting and colorful way.

### **ADDITIONAL**

How to use the features learned in a “fun for student’s” way:

#### **REVIEW GAMES**

Insert a table and make each space a different category. Then use hyperlinks to take them to questions. Now have them answer the questions and link the answer to correct or incorrect slides. Make links between the slides.

**Use the student’s competitiveness to motivate them to learn!**

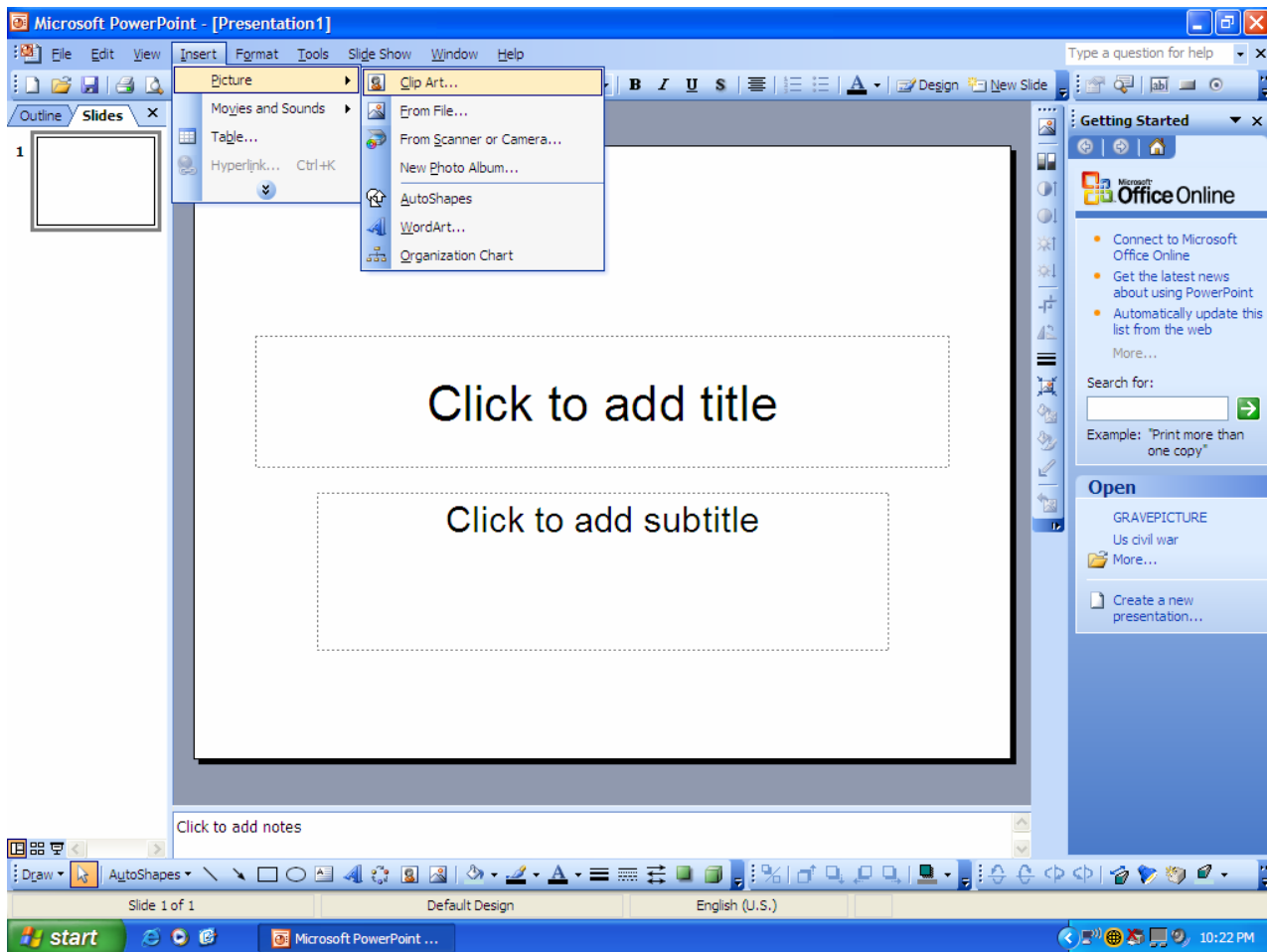


## APPENDIX A

### For non-linear and linear presentations.

How to insert a picture:

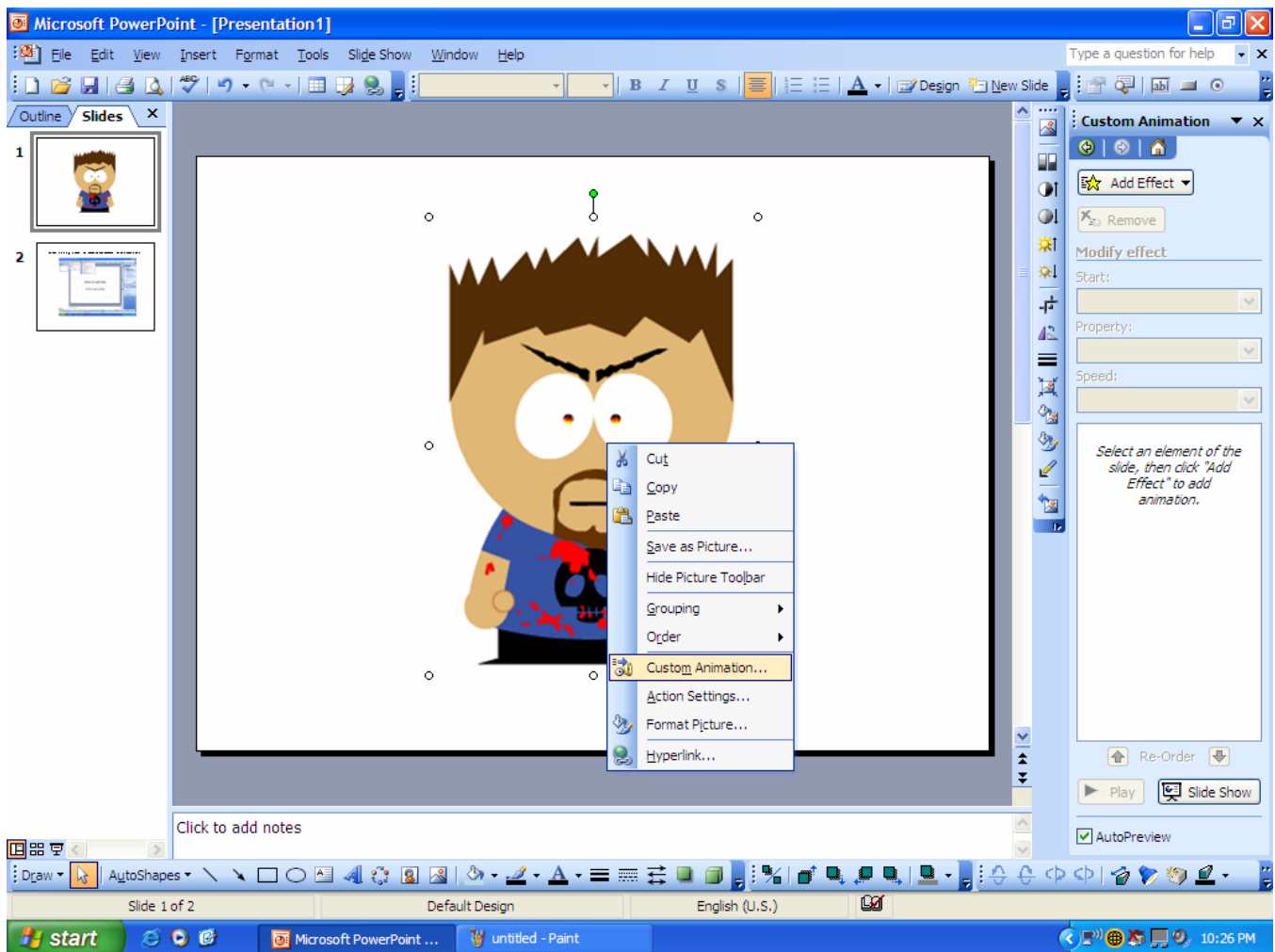
1. Click “insert”, “picture”, and then select from what source the picture is in.
2. Now you are able to change the size and color of the picture.





How to animate the picture or words:

1. Right click on the picture or words and then click “custom animation”.
2. On the right hand side the custom animation tools popped up.
3. Start experimenting with different animations.



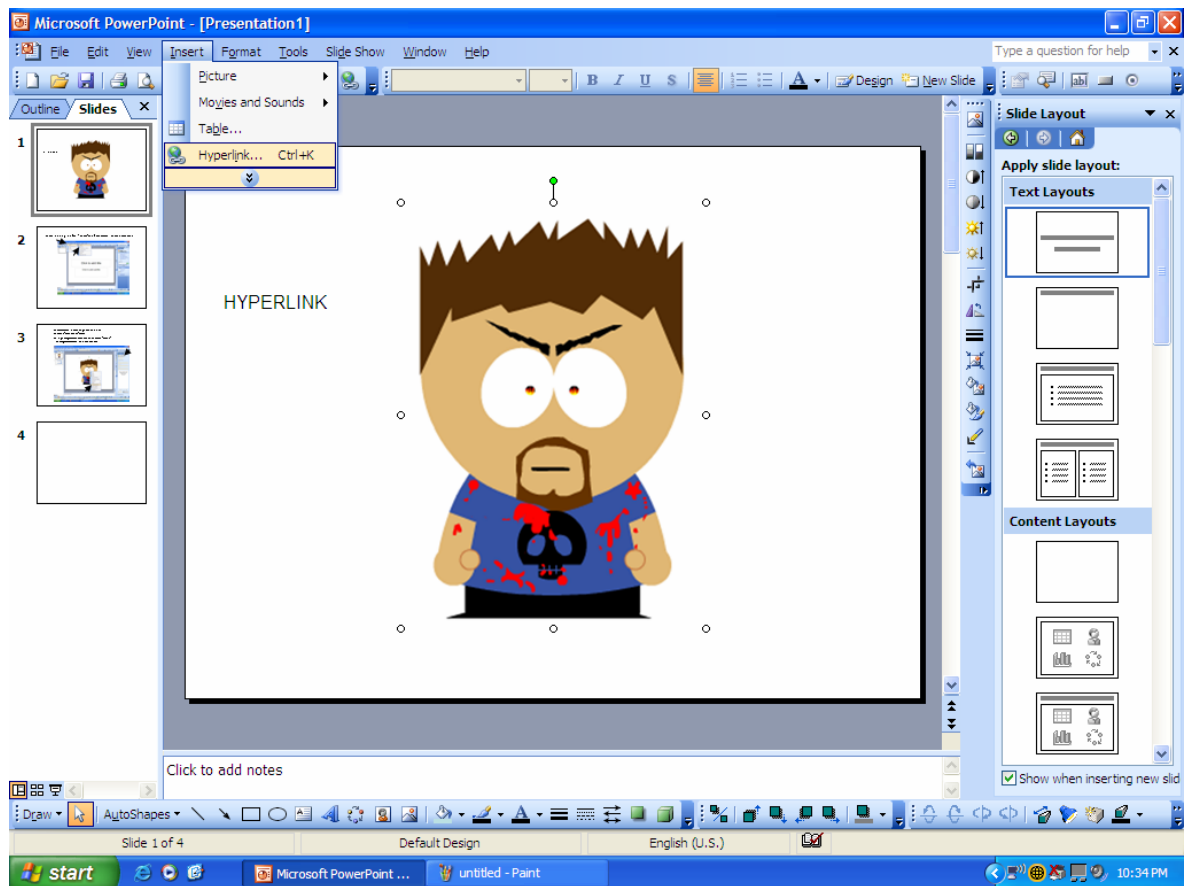


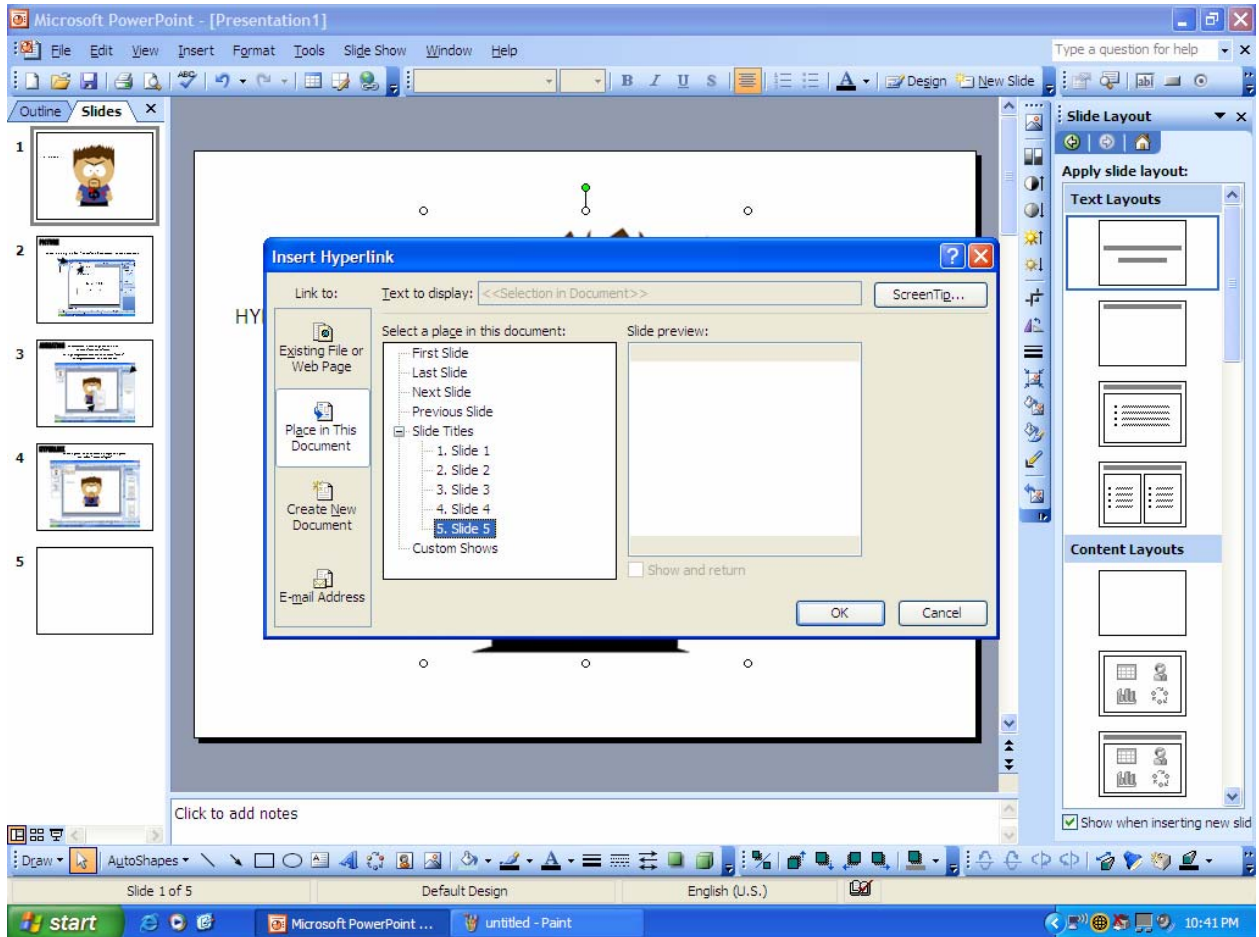
## APPENDIX B

### For a non-linear presentation only.

How to insert a hyperlink:

1. Click on the picture or word you want to place a hyperlink.
2. Click “insert”, “hyperlink”.
3. The Insert Hyperlink Box will pop up.
4. If you want to hyperlink within a Presentation, click on “Place in this Document”.
5. Now select which slide you would like to hyperlink to.  
NOTE: you always will first need a place to hyperlink to.
